NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Notice is hereby given that the Santa Cruz County Regional Transportation Commission (hereinafter "SCCRTC"), will receive sealed bids at 1523 Pacific Avenue, Santa Cruz, CA 95060, California, during the business hours of 8:00 AM through 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday, holidays excepted, for:

Santa Cruz Branch Line Bridge Supports, Repairs and Member Replacements, according to the drawings and specifications prepared by: J. L. Patterson & Associates, Inc. and described in general as: Improvements to the Santa Cruz Branch Line, located in Santa Cruz and Monterey County, California, including bridge supports, repairs and member replacements. The bid shall include all labor, materials, equipment, and incidentals required to support, repair or replace bridge members and all the related and miscellaneous work described in the Contract Documents. The bid for this rehabilitation work will span the Santa Cruz Branch Line for a project of approximately 31.4 miles generally between Watsonville, California at approximate mile post (MP) 0.04 and Davenport, California at approximate MP 31.8 in Santa Cruz County, California.

Each Bidder shall include in his bid and provide all labor, tools, and materials for a complete and working Project in conformance with the intent shown on the drawings and specified herein.

SCCRTC affirms that in any Contact entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation. Bidders are advised that this project is subjected to all federal, state and local nondiscrimination laws.

Bids will be received until 2:00 p.m. on May 10, 2013, after which time bids will be opened and read aloud at SCCRTC.

Each Bidder must submit a proposal to the governing board on the Bid Form enclosed. Said proposal shall be accompanied by cash, a cashier's check, a certified check or Bidder's bond of ten percent (10%) of the amount of the bid submitted, to be made payable to the SCCRTC. Bid bonds shall be issued by a corporate surety duly admitted and authorized to issue bonds and undertakings by the State of California, on the Bid Bond form provided by SCCRTC.

Pursuant to Section 1700, and following, of the California Labor Code, the Contractor shall pay not less than the prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. Copies of such prevailing rate of per diem wages are on file at the office of SCCRTC, 1523 Pacific Avenue, Santa Cruz, CA 95060. Those copies shall be made available to any interested party upon request. The Contractor shall forfeit, as

penalty to SCCRTC, Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each calendar day or portion thereof, for each workman paid less than the stipulated prevailing rates for any work done under the contract by it or by any subcontractor under it, in violation of the provisions of such Labor Code.

Pursuant to Section 22300 of the Public Contract Code, the Contractor may substitute a deposit of securities in lieu of SCCRTC withholding any monies to ensure Contractor's performance under the Contract, or alternatively, request that SCCRTC make payment of retentions earned directly to an escrow agent at the expense of Contractor. The provisions of Public Contract Code section 22300 are incorporated herein by reference as though set forth in full, and shall govern the substitution of securities and/or escrow account.

Securities eligible for investment under this section shall include those listed in Section 16430 of the Government Code, and bank or savings and loan certificates of deposit.

No partial sets will be issued. All plans will be provided as half-size sets. Full size plan sets will not be available until after bid award for as-built record sets.


