Call Box Maintenance and Improvements
Proposer's Conference - April 6, 2012
Questions and Answers**

Questions received before or during the conference

- 1. Will the Request for Proposals (RFP) be amended if the determination from the Department of Industrial Relations concerning call box maintenance work provides information that was not considered in the RFP?** If the RFP does not follow the requirements of the Department of Industrial Relations, the RFP will be amended to incorporate any new information from the determination.
- 2. Will the RTC be providing a price sheet or should the proposer create one?** The RFP did not include a price sheet. The proposers should provide a price proposal that shall include full compensation for maintenance and ADA improvement work as discussed in Attachment A, Scope of Work.
- 3. Is it possible to obtain a copy of the current contract and copies of the last 6 months of invoices?** Yes, the current contract and invoices are available on the RTC website (<http://SCCRTC.org/about/opportunities/rfp/>).
- 4. Can a contractor have a class "C" CA state contractor's license and meet the minimum qualifications?** A contractor can meet the minimum qualifications with a California State contractor's license, classification "A", "C7", or "C10". An addendum noting this change in the minimum qualifications can be found on the RTC website (<http://SCCRTC.org/about/opportunities/rfp/>).
- 5. Who performs the current call box maintenance work?** CASE Systems Inc. is the current contractor performing the call box maintenance work.
- 6. Will the RTC SAFE provide a list of the current call box equipment inventory?** There are 120 operational call boxes in the field. Two additional call boxes with associated electronics, pole, auger, signs and solar panel are in storage and will be reinstalled after the completion of the Highway 1 Auxiliary Lane project. There is an additional call box and electronics in storage and the pole, auger, signs and solar panel are in the field as there is no cell service at this site.
