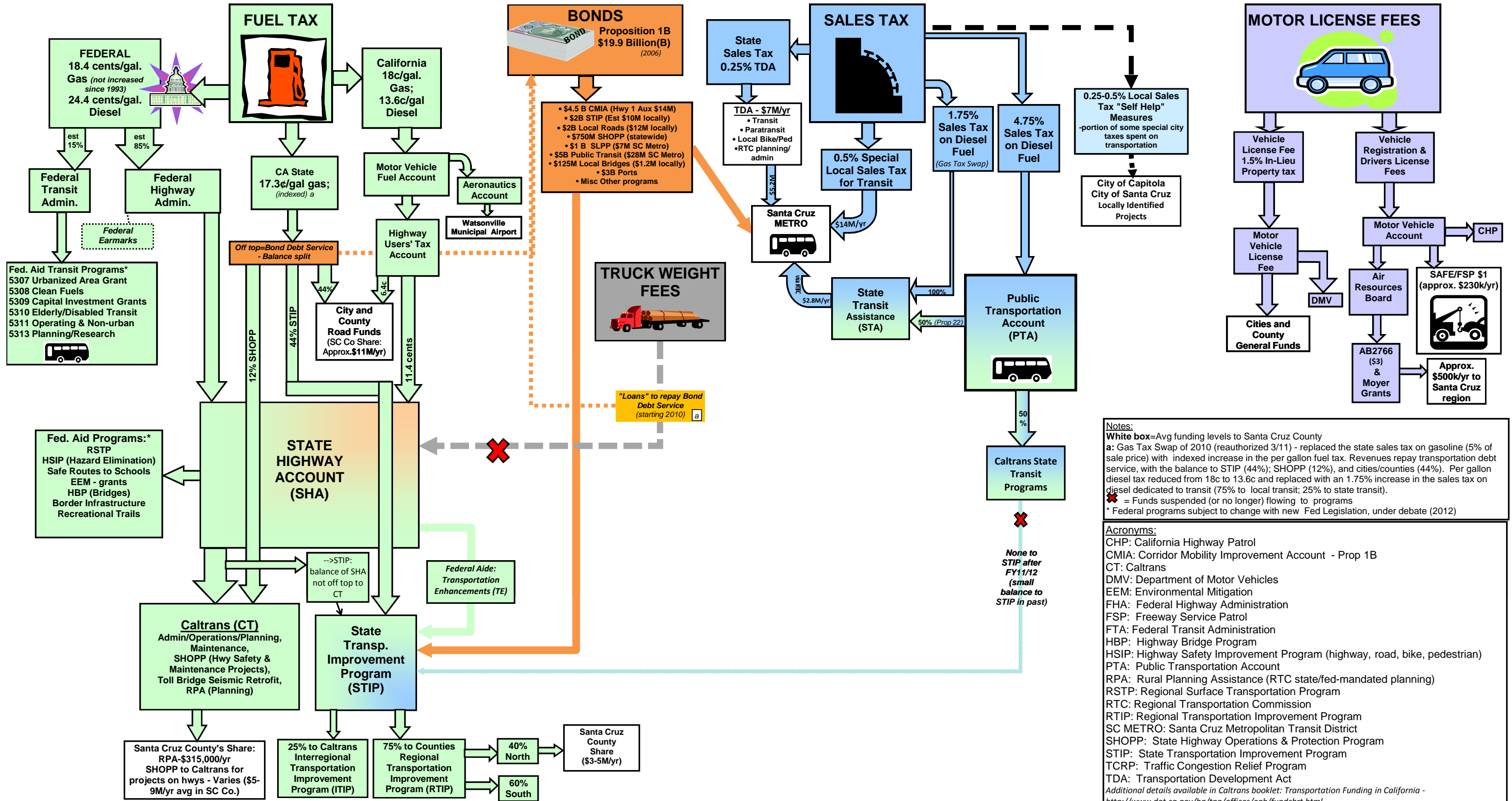


# Transportation Funding in California - Overview

Subject to constant change based on new legislation, voter actions, annual budgets



**Notes:**  
**White box**=Avg funding levels to Santa Cruz County  
**a:** Gas Tax Swap of 2010 (reauthorized 3/11) - replaced the state sales tax on gasoline (5% of sale price) with indexed increase in the per gallon fuel tax. Revenues repay transportation debt service, with the balance to STIP (44%); SHOPP (12%), and cities/counties (44%). Per gallon diesel tax reduced from 18c to 13.6c and replaced with an 1.75% increase in the sales tax on diesel dedicated to transit (75% to local transit; 25% to state transit).
