Draft 2019 Public Participation Plan Public Hearing

Alternative Analysis for High Capacity Public Transit on the Rail Right-of-Way – Scope of Work for Request for Proposals

The Regional Transportation Commission (RTC) intends to engage the services of a consultant to produce an Alternatives Analysis and Business Plan for High Capacity Public Transit on the Rail Right-of-Way. The Alternatives Analysis will evaluate public transit investment options that provide an integrated transit network for Santa Cruz County utilizing all or part of the length of the rail right-of-way as a dedicated transit facility. A performance-based planning approach based on a triple bottom line sustainability framework will be utilized to assess various public transit options for the rail right of way. The RTC reviewed and provided input on the draft scope of work that will be released in the request for proposals on Monday, August 5, 2019.
