
# Preliminary Draft Goals & Policies

**2050** Regional Transportation Plan

## What is a regional transportation plan?

The RTP is a state mandated longrange transportation plan and investment strategy that identifies transportation needs over the next twenty-plus years and is prepared every **four** years.



## The RTP includes 3 main elements



## Policy

Identifies the transportation goals, policies, and performance targets for Santa Cruz County.



## Action

Lists projects and programs needed to operate, maintain and improve the transportation system in SC County.



## **Financial**

Estimates the amount of funds that will likely be available for transportation projects over the 25-year RTP timeframe.

Reduce vehicle miles traveled (VMT) in order to establish livable communities that improve people's access to their regular needs.

#### Policies

multimodal access for all ages and abilities, improving transit/ped/bike networks, dedicated transit facilities, human-centered, smart land use

Eliminate transportation related fatalities and injuries for all transportation modes

#### **Policies**

fund safety projects and programs to achieve Vision Zero, safety for youth/vulnerable/disadvantaged, emergency services, system design, security

Deliver transportation improvements cost-effectively, responsive to the needs of all users of the system

#### **Policies**

Support cost-effective projects, maintenance and operations, interagency coordination, Transportation System Management, new taxes or fees, goods movement, public engagement

Establish a climate-resilient transportation system that anticipates, adapts to, and mitigates the impacts of climate change

#### **Policies**

Nature based, climate adaptation, climate mitigation, Transportation Demand Management, proactive planning

Ensure that plans, investments, policies, and transportation decisions reduce disparities for historically and systemically marginalized, underserved, and excluded groups, including people with low incomes, people with disabilities, communities of color, and other transportation-disadvantaged and equity priority communities

#### **Policies**

Disparities in access and safety, public engagement, priority of climate resiliency solutions and transportation investments, displacement impacts
