




Safe on 17 CHP Enforcement

Partnership with CHP and MTC SAFE to provide additional traffic enforcement on Highway 17 to ensure safe driving speeds.

- Current agreements expires June 30, 2024
- New 3-year agreements to continue funding additional CHP for Highway 17
- \$100,000 annual contribution from RTC
- \$50,000 annual contribution from MTC



Freeway Service Patrol

FSP clears vehicle accidents, picks up dangerous items left on the roadway and helps stranded motorists.

Last year in numbers:

- 548 assists on Highway 1
- 671 assists on Highway 17
- Hwy 1 FSP: Mon-Fri 6:00am 9:00am, select weekends
- Hwy 17 FSP: Mon-Fri 6:30am 9:30am, Sun 1-7pm




Call Boxes

Roadside call boxes also provide an important service for motorists without cell phones, and in areas with unreliable cellular reception.

- 70 call boxes located throughout Santa Cruz County
- 19 call boxes on Highway 17
- 511 mobile call box in Santa Clara County

Safe on 17 Annual Report

Reviews the work done by the CHP, Caltrans, SCCRTC and other stakeholders to continue to improve safety on Highway 17.

2023 Summary

- 636 total collisions on Highway 17
- 5 fatal collisions and 197 injury collisions
- 822 overtime citations issued
- 923 overtime hours logged









Grind pavement, place Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA), and apply High Friction Surface Treatment (HFST) and contrasting surface treatment to improve safety.




Wildlife Habitat Crossing

Construct wildlife undercrossing. Project in CLOSE OUT.




Roadway Improvement Project

Construct improvements on SR 17 and upgrade the SR 17/SR 9 interchange in the Town of Los Gatos. Project IN DESIGN




Wildlife & Trail Crossings
